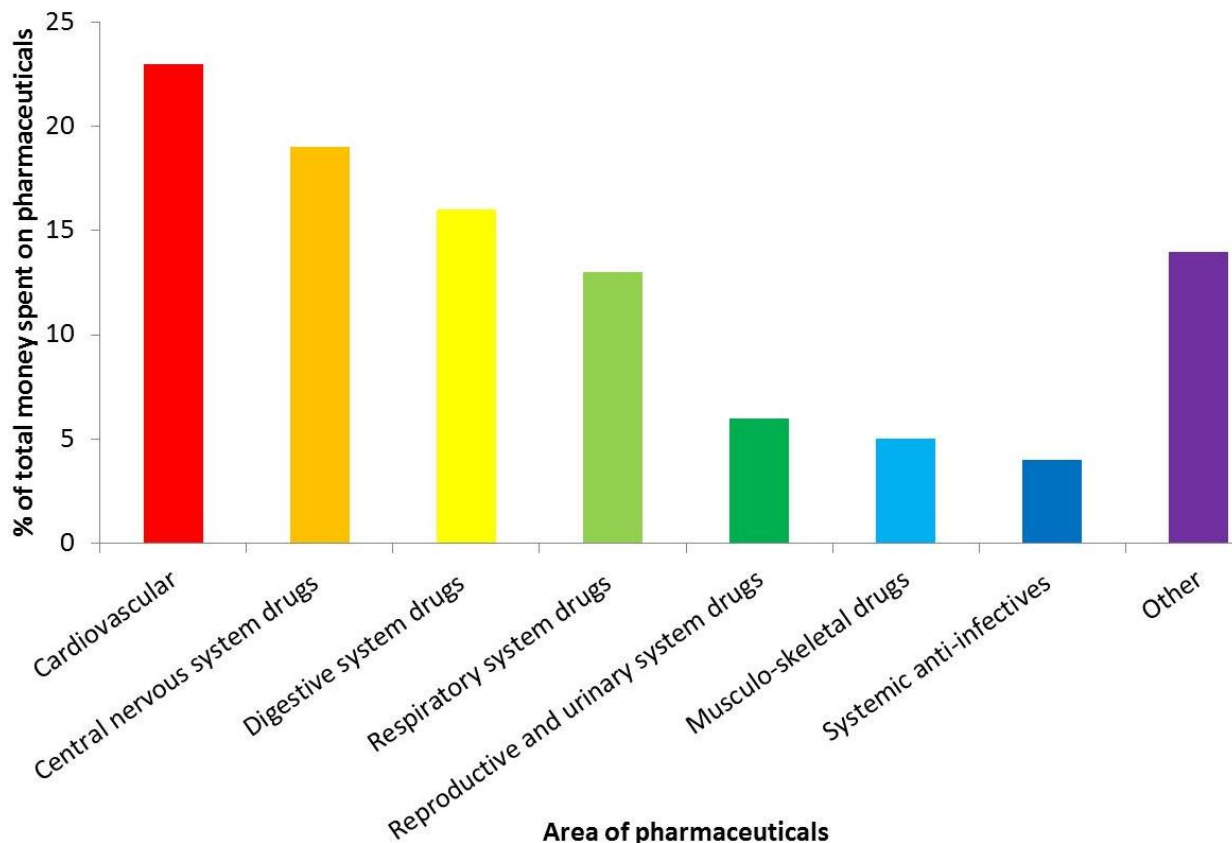


Figure: Chart to show the percentage of the total amount of money spent on different areas of pharmaceuticals.

	Cardiovascular (heart drugs)	23%
	Central nervous system drugs (eg painkillers, antidepressants)	19%
	Digestive system drugs (eg antacids, ulcer drugs and drugs for diabetes)	16%
	Respiratory system drugs (eg drugs for asthma and hay fever)	13%
	Reproductive and urinary system drugs	6%
	Musculo-skeletal drugs	5%
	Systemic anti-infectives (antibiotics and Aids drugs)	4%
	Other	14%
